### Extended Devotion:

Are you a worn-out mother? Do you wake every morning lacking the ability to carry on your tasks for the day? Fellow Mama, I have been there more than you know. Did you know that God sees you! Just as God saw Hagar in the desert and Hannah on her knees, He sees you at the lowest moments. God sees you on the mountain and the valley. More than that, God values you and all the noble things you do in your motherhood.

Why is it hard for us to find worth in our motherhood? Perhaps it's the temptation of comparison, our weariness, our anxieties, and so much more. But as we pursue virtue in our Christian walk our motherhood journey, God says that those deeds surpass all others. We are loved, cherished, His alone. Amid our daunting tasks and anxiety-plagued seasons, we can still pursue virtue in motherhood. How can we do that when seasons are hard? When we feel like a failure regardless of what we do, how can we embrace the importance of our calling?

### **When we embrace our worth as mothers when we embrace our identity in Christ.**

One of the marks of a virtuous woman is the fear of the Lord. A woman who fears the Lord is praised (Proverbs 31:30). As mothers, our worth, our beauty is found in who we are in Christ. The title of "Daughter of Christ" far surpasses the title of "Mom." Motherhood can cause us to seek His face in the darkness and the light. We can pursue virtue and find the importance of our calling as we choose faithfulness in all seasons.

Proverbs 9:10 (ESV) says, "*Charm is deceptive, and beauty is fleeting; but a woman who fears the Lord is to be praised.*" Our beauty, our worth is not found in the things we do, but who we are in Christ.

### Application:

1. Set aside a few precious moments and read Proverbs 31. Take a few additional moments and meditate on thoughts the Holy Spirit brings to your mind.
2. There were so many wonderful verses in today's episode! Write out Psalm 139:14 and let it serve as a reminder of our worth in Christ.
